

Until Mar. 31: Early Bird 10% Bonus!

Welcoming 2021 means welcoming 2021 bonuses and we are starting early this year! All new Pre-Notification Applications and/or new Final Applications submitted Jan. 21, 2021 through Mar. 31, 2021 will be

bonused 10% of the total incentive, provided the application is paid during the original reservation period.

Starts Feb. 25: LEEP Bonus



LEEP (Large Energy Efficiency Project) AHEAD! Get a 20% bonus for submitting final applications over \$35,000 by July 31, 2021 or a 10% bonus for submitting the final application by Sept. 15, 2021.

This bonus plays nice with the Early Bird 10% Bonus, which is paid to customers. The LEEP Bonus is paid to the Trade Ally. Both bonuses will be paid out to each party for any eligible overlapping paid final

application.

Funds may exhaust early, so be one of the first to LEEP AHEAD and capture your bonus.

Trade Ally Rewards - Cash them in now!

Reminder, 2020 program year (Dec. 1, 2019 - Nov. 30, 2020) points expire on Feb. 28, 2021. They will be removed from your account on Mar. 1, 2021, if not

redeemed. No exceptions.

Points earned from the 2021 program year (Dec. 1, 2020 - Nov. 30, 2021) will remain in your account and not expire until Feb. 28, 2022. The 2021 program year points cap is back to 200,000 and at the normal points earning rates.





2021 top incentive opportunity by energy efficiency measure:





Small Business Quality Inspection Bonuses:

Criteria	Bonus Amount
80%-89% pass rate	\$50 per passed inspection
90% pass rate	\$75 per passed inspection
100% pass rate	Additional \$5,000

The bonus is assessed quarterly and a minimum of five projects must be completed within that quarter to be eligible for the bonus.
