

## E10 Electric 10% Bonus: Q4 2021

### E10 Bonus

Earn a 10% bonus on the total electric incentive for final applications received between Nov. 1, 2021 to Dec. 17, 2021. The 10% bonus is applied to the current incentive amount found in the Incentive Application. The 10% bonus is applied to the original incentive, before any other bonus, including a Buy Michigan bonus, if applicable.

The E10 bonus will be paid to the payee as stated in the Final Application. The E10 bonus is capped as a \$20,000 bonus per project. All other program rules must be followed.

### E10 Bonus Eligibility

Eligible participants submit a final application and follow the official rules to receive the E10 bonus for electric incentives.

### Official Rules

**Consumers Energy Business Energy Efficiency Programs is offering incentive bonuses under the Business Energy Efficiency Programs for qualifying projects completed by their qualifying customers and paid during Nov. 1, 2021 to Dec. 17, 2021.**
