



project.

# **Extending Bonuses in 2023**

## **Trade Ally Reward Points**

On Dec. 1, 2022, any paid applications/transactions will apply to the 2023 program year point accumulation. Meaning, if you are currently capped at 200,000 you will start to earn points with the January deposit, for paid projects in December.

The points cap for 2023 is still 200,000. With large enough applications you can max out your points in the January and February points deposits and could have up to 400,000 points in your account by Feb. 20, 2023, ahead of the Feb. 28 points expiration date for 2022 points. If you are saving for something large, this is your chance! Contact Mindie with questions.

#### **Business Instant Discount**

Our program offers instant discounts on boilers at \$2/MBH and RTUs at up to \$785. Use the Find A Distributor link to find your local distributor or connect with your Energy Advisor to learn more.

Flat Panels have been approved for the Business Instant Discount Program. You can now purchase flat panels for your customers from participating distributors. Reminder, the max sale is 20 units per customer.



Extended in 2023! Business Instant Discount distributors are invited to offer an extra 15% instant discount on USA made products sold by distributors (bonus will not be applied if the current discount exceeds the product MSRP).

An affidavit must be filled out, submitted, and approved BEFORE the transaction occurs, to ensure the distributor's reimbursement.


