

## 22% in 2022 K-12 School Bonus

In support of our schools, we are excited to offer a 22% bonus on any qualifying project to aid in providing a better learning environment for K-12 students.

This is a 22% bonus for K-12 Michigan schools for electric and/or natural gas incentives. The bonus will be calculated based on the paid incentive amount before any other bonus is calculated. Starting May 1, 2022, any new pre-notification application or new final application submitted to the Program with a final application submitted no later than Nov. 1, 2022, will be eligible. Previous/existing projects submitted in 2022 do not qualify. Only new projects are eligible. Any projects previously applied for and cancelled, even if re-submitted will not qualify for this bonus. The bonus will automatically apply to all K-12 school applications when the primary business type "School (K-8)" or "High School" is selected on the application.

### Eligibility

K-12 Michigan schools with an electric and/or natural gas project, no minimum incentive amount. Final application must be submitted by Nov. 1, 2022.
