The Challenge:

Making the most of limited funding is a top priority in a non-profit endeavor. Caring for our active-duty and veteran military personnel is no exception. That's why the VFW National Home (VNH) in Eaton Rapids, MI was looking for ways to stretch their budget to provide the best housing possible for military members and families.

The Solution:

In early 2024, leadership at VNH was contacted by their gas provider, Consumers Energy to gauge their interest in reducing energy costs. Consumers Energy connected VNH with one of their preferred energy experts, who provided a free walkthrough and a full report on savings opportunities throughout the facility.

The walkthrough revealed thousands in potential savings from the installation of faucet aerators, a programmable thermostat and water heater blankets. Plus, as a non-profit organization, VNH qualified to receive the equipment and installation labor at no cost.

The Result:

Leaders at VNH acted on the findings and approved installation of the recommended energy-saving equipment. The updates are projected to save over 1,200 MCF of natural gas and up to \$6,300 in costs each year.
