

Michigan Business Online Application FAQ

Q: When will the Consumers Energy Online Application go away?

A: Oct. 1, 2022 is when we plan to transition to the Michigan Business Online Application instead of the Consumers Energy only application. The URL Consumersenergy.com/easyapp will bring you to the Michigan Business Online Application starting Oct. 1.

Q: I have a Consumers Energy and DTE online application login which one do I use?

A: Both logins will work, we suggest you use whichever account has the most applications submitted.

Q: Can one of my Consumers Energy energy advisors help me with my DTE projects?

A: No, go to your respective energy advisor for help and direction for each utility.

Q: I don't see my past application I have entered in the Consumers Energy or DTE only online application, when will the other apps be in the Michigan Business Online Application?

A: We plan on any application entered into either utility's online application to be available in your online application login in later this year.

Q: I see there are separate Final Incentive Agreement forms for Consumers Energy and DTE projects, why?

A: We are working on creating a joint Final Incentive Agreement

Q: Where is the Rebate Processor field in the Michigan Business Online Application?

A: It will be added back later this year.

Q: Will all my uploaded documents be in my new Michigan Business Online Application?

A: Yes, you will not need to re-upload any document that you saved to your profile in either the Consumers Energy or DTE only online applications.
